## A FREE ART EVENT IN AND AROUND ONE OF LIMERICKS OLDEST CITY CENTRE STREETS FOR THE WEEKEND OF MAY 11 2012.

The artists for this years Catherine St CATDIG weekend line up have been chosen by curator Lotte Bender, an artist at LSAD. An exciting and diverse set of contemporary work will now be shown in a series of participating venues for the weekend of May 11.

This year CATDIG has recieved intrest from the fine art Community and wandering will be rewarded with a chance to see a range of out of the Gallery subject matter and techniques. As ever thanks to the participating traders of one of Limericks oldest streets and our sponsors Beamish. Every event is free as the intention is to wander and enjoy the third year of CATDIG. The Little Catherine St bookshop will host a science based video installation by Carla Burns as well as etchings by Joe Ryan. Cellia O Donnell's Clothes shop will also host the video 'Sea Journeys' by LSAD's Declan Casey. Art Links Limerick will project their creative investigation into CATA the Shannon River Monster, as a night time experiance on both nights for late night wandering. Elephant Talks, the vibrant arts discussion hosted by Ormston House and the School of Architecture will be in Frenches Cafe at 6 o Clock on Friday 11.

Street activity includes a performance based on the old Irish Civil Defence nuclear war pamphlets, Mitch Conlon will be warning us all again on Saturday. Also on Saturday will be Josie O Connors dance drawing collaboration, Steve Mahers Time Capsule, Mary Conroys sunflower seed search and Anastasia Artemeva's exchange project featuring code loaded objects which she will present to the participating public.

Paul Quast 's subject matter revolves around dilapidated materials as physical signs of excess. His structure in Bourkes laneway will explain all. Fredricke Le Clerc will host a Saturday compositional workshop on the street at 5, so do bring objects to participate in the creation of a unique score. Finally, Catherine Street resident Ann Daly will host her own paintings in Lady Penelope's Shop. Other events will pop up as fringe events do bring out the curious performer on the day and O Connells Butchers and Gleasons Shop will be contributing foodwise. The streets bars will of course be providing music and more in the weekends lead in and lead out.
